## MEMBERS' DISCOUNTS



Discounts of a minimum of 50% on seeds ordered via the Society's bulk order scheme, organised by the Secretary in September/October.

## HORTICULTURAL SHOWS

Compete with other members in our local shows, in the Spring (March/April) and in the Autumn (September). Win cups and trophies, or simply come and enjoy the displays and perfume. It costs members only 25p to enter each exhibit and the public are charged an admission fee of £1 to enter. **As a member you get in free and get a free show schedule.**

**SUBSCRIPTIONS** – our financial year runs from 1st December to 30th November and the club rules require all members to renew subscriptions by 31st March. You could save over £10 per year by joining if you attend all our events free to members. The bi-monthly Newsletter is emailed to members who provide an email address, or hand delivered in the village. If you do not have an email address and you live outside this area, it can be posted to you for a postage levy of £3 pa. (Only one levy per household is charged, e.g. if more than one member lives at the same address). These subscriptions are set at the AGM in January. Your name, address, telephone no. and email address are kept on a computer for our records only, and are not passed to any 3rd party.
