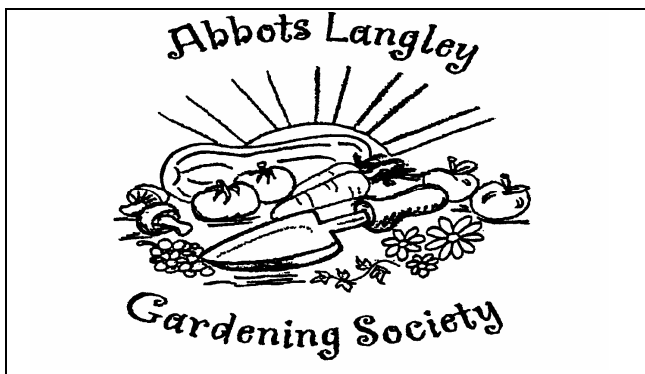
Free admission to the Royal National Rose Society at Chiswell Green, plus discounts on rose bushes bought there, and ordered via the Secretary.

SUBSCRIPTIONS – our financial year runs from 1st December to 30th November and the club rules require all members to renew subscriptions by 31st March, to obtain a discount of £1. Thereafter the full payment is required. You save £6 per year by joining if you attend all events. The bi-monthly Newsletter is hand delivered by the Committee but if you live outside this area you can receive this by email or pay a postage levy of £2. If one or more members live at the same address, only one postage levy is payable. These rates are set at the AGM in January. Your name, address and telephone are kept on a computer for our records only and are not passed to any 3rd party.
